COVID-19 Vaccine Scheduling Will Open for Those 70 Years & Older on February 1

(Millersburg, Ohio) - Beginning the week of February 1, the Holmes County General Health District will begin scheduling COVID-19 vaccine appointments to those in the third group of Phase 1B under Ohio's COVID-19 Vaccination Plan. This group will include those individuals **70 years and older** and all other individuals 75+ years and older who are still interested in receiving a vaccine. The health department is still receiving a very limited number of vaccines and we ask the public to be patient as we move through this process. Some individuals may be briefly placed on a wait list and receive a call back to schedule their vaccine appointment once additional supply is available.

Those 70 years and older can begin scheduling their vaccine appointment by calling the health department at 330-674-5035 starting on Monday, February 1, 2021. A location and information on what to bring to your appointment will be provided during scheduling. We ask that all individuals and caregivers wear a mask when attending their appointment.

Pomerene Hospital will also be providing vaccines for the above groups as supply allows. Please call (330) 674-1584 ext. 1066 for more information on appointments.

Vaccine scheduling for those 65 years and older is tentatively expected to begin on February 8 and will likely continue for several weeks. No additional information has been released by Governor DeWine regarding vaccines for those under 65 at this time.
